FOREWORD



Dear friends,

If I had to sum up the work of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) after almost one year as its Chairperson, I would say that it opens windows of opportunity that might have otherwise remained closed. The Organization's work aims to de-escalate tensions, build confidence,

create dialogue in spaces where there is none, and slowly but surely fill in the divides created during the Cold War. Moreover, having traveled to 15 different OSCE field missions this year, I have seen first-hand that this Organization works closely alongside national actors, striving to create more stable and prosperous conditions for the people on the ground.

Slovakia took the helm of the OSCE in January 2019 because we wanted to do our part in supporting its comprehensive approach to security. At a time when the nature and scope of conflicts is rapidly shifting; when transnational challenges are proliferating; when the security threats that led to the Helsinki Final Act continue to cast a shadow over this continent, I would argue that we need this approach more so now than ever before.

This OSCE Ministerial Council convenes nearly 45 years after the signing of the Helsinki Final Act, and 30 years after peaceful demonstrations for freedom, democracy and human rights led to the birth of my own country. If ever there was a time to focus on what unites rather than divides us, and to recommit to the principles of the Organization we formed to create a safer future for us all, this is it.

This 26th Ministerial Council Meeting of the OSCE not only acts as a window into the work of this Organization over this past year, but it is also a forum for dialogue among decision-makers on the most pressing security challenges facing this region. You – the representatives of the media – are the link between the Ministerial Council and the people on the ground that this Organization was established to serve. You can open the window even further; you can make this dialogue platform more robust.

I therefore welcome your active participation at this Ministerial Council and I wish you a pleasant stay in Bratislava!

VENUE



Meetings of the Preparatory Committee and other OSCE bodies will take place at the same venue starting on 2 December 2019. Media representatives can access the site of the Ministerial Council through Gate B0 only.

Bratislava has two main train stations. There are regular hourly trains from Vienna Central station to both stations in Bratislava.

- If you arrive at Bratislava Petržalka, please take Bus No. 80 direction "Kollárovo nám." and get off at the stop "Einsteinova". The bus runs every 12 minutes.
- If you arrive at Bratislava Hlavná stanica, please take Bus No. 93 direction
 "Vyšehradská" and change at the stop
 "Zochova" to the bus no. 80 direction
 "Kollárovo nám." and get off at the stop
 "Einsteinova".

Public transport can be used free of charge with a valid Ministerial Council badge.



MEDIA CENTRE

The following facilities are available in the media centre:

POOL ARRANGEMENTS

At the Media Information Desk, journalists can receive information and register for access to events during the Ministerial Council for which pool arrangements will apply due to space, security and protocol restrictions.

Pool participation is primarily for photographers and cameraoperators.

Journalists are requested to register for a pool **ahead of time and in-person** at the Media Information Desk.

As space is limited, registration will be provided on a firstcome-first-served basis.

The complete pool programme will be available at the media information desk.

All journalists admitted to a specific pool must gather at least 15 minutes before the pool departs at the media information desk in order to receive a separate, mandatory "floater badge". Journalists will be escorted as a group. At the end of the press opportunity, the pool will be escorted back to the media centre. Journalists that arrive late at the pool meeting point will forfeit their access to the pool.

Please note that MC media events outside the media centre will be covered exclusively by the TV host broadcaster. A world feed and footage will be provided free of charge to all media.

Delegations are responsible for contacting media representatives and the media information desk in the media centre or through their liaison officer **at least 20 minutes** before the start of the bilateral meeting to allow for media representatives to be escorted.

GENERAL INFORMATION

CURRENCY

The official currency in Slovakia is the Euro. For more information about ECB foreign exchange reference rates, see: https://www.nbs.sk/en/statistics/exchange-rates/ecb-foreign-exchange-reference-rates

BANKS AND CREDIT CARDS

Most banks are open from Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 18:00. Almost all banks have ATMs that accept overseas bank cards and are accessible from outside. It is recommended to check with the issuing bank before departure whether a bank card is valid in Slovakia. Credit cards, such as American Express, MasterCard and Visa are widely accepted in Slovakia.

BUSINESS HOURS

Shops are generally open from Monday to Saturday from 10:00 to 18:00, though times may vary. Shopping malls are open until 21:00. On Sundays, large stores and shopping malls are open.

ELECTRICITY

The electric current used is 220/230 volts, 50 Hz (continental European standard).

CLIMATE

In December, the average temperatures in Bratislava are usually around -1,7°C to 2,8°C.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT BRATISLAVA

Bratislava is a metropolitan city with almost half a million population. It became the capital of Slovakia in 1993 when the Slovak Republic was founded. Its location is unique: it is the only capital in the world located on the border of three countries – Slovakia, Austria and Hungary, and the closest one to another capital – Vienna. Bratislava is the political, educational, cultural and economic center of Slovakia. Unique history, attractive sights, rich cultural life, excellent local gastronomy, quality wine and modern shopping centers make Bratislava an ideal city-break destination. As an environmentally friendly city on the Danube, Bratislava and its region has unspoilt natural treasures and protected natural habitats of European significance.
